Any question regarding submission or the reviewing process should be directed to acit@ccis2k.org. A final preparation format is available in the conference web site. Before final acceptance, all referees' comments must be considered and the paper must be formatted according to IEEE camera-ready instructions that are provided in the conference web site. Authors of the best selected papers presented at the conference will be invited to prepare an extended version of their papers to be considered for publication in a special issue of The International Arab Journal of Information Technology (IAJIT). IAJIT is a Worldwide recognized Journal indexed in major scientific databases: ISI/SCI, SCOPUS, DBLP, among others.

EVALUATION PROCESS

The evaluation of submitted papers is based on the importance and usefulness of the research topic. Technical merits, novelty of the approach, soundness of results, and clarity of presentation are also considered as factors of the evaluation process. The papers will go through a Plagiarism system to insure their originality. Each article will be fully refereed by a minimum of two specialized referees.
